

# BARN RULES

1. **NO SMOKING:** Cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other types smoking are prohibited under the roofs of the barns or within 50ft of barns. Please extinguish fully and throw away in trash, DO NOT leave on ground.
2. **HALTERS:** We recommend that halters be removed from horses in stalls and turnout areas. If halters must be left on, leather or breakaway halters are required.
3. **CROSSTIES:** No horse is to be left unattended tied on crossties. Manure should be dumped in designated areas only. Return tack, rakes, tools, etc. to their appropriate places. Please sweep before leaving area.
4. **HELMETS:** ASTM/SEI helmets are required at all times when riding unless indicated on waiver. When jumping, helmets must always be worn, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. **CHILDREN:**
  - a. No unattended children are allowed. Children are not allowed (until they have reached their 13th birthday) at the barn without adult supervision.
  - b. Children are not allowed (until they have reached their 13th birthday) to handle and/or ride any horse on the premises unless an adult (over 18), who is responsible and supervises the child, comes with the child onto the premises and accompanies the child at all times the child is handling and/or riding horses on the premises.
6. **EMERGENCY VET CARE:** In an emergency, a vet will be called at your expense if you cannot be reached or if you fail to take appropriate measures.
7. **VISITORS:**
  - a. If you bring friends or relatives, they will be expected to follow all the rules and regulations applying to this facility. Failure to do so will result in them and possibly you, being asked to leave. All riders must sign a waiver, if under 18 the waiver must be signed by parent or legal guardian.
  - b. No visitors are allowed in pastures. Only owner/lessor of horse may enter pastures.
8. **FACILITY:** Boarders are not allowed to make changes to stall, tack area or any other aspect of farm property.
9. **COMMUNITY:** Help your fellow riders and boarders, always try to work together. Infighting, gossiping and general poor behavior towards people or horses will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave if this occurs.
10. **LIGHTS:** Turn off all lights when leaving and close all doors in cold weather.
11. **BARN HOURS:** are between 7am and 10 pm. If you need to be at the barn outside of the designated hours, please let management know ahead of time
12. **RIDING AREAS:**
  - a. Please check the Band App for lesson times and try to schedule your riding time during a private lesson, not a group. Lessons will take precedence over all other ring use.
  - b. **CLEAN UP** your poop in ring after riding. Either throw by manure area or inside muck tubs
13. **JUMPING:** Jumping is NOT permitted unless in a lesson. Boarders and Lessors may use poles as they wish but please return as you found them or put to the side of arena after use.
14. **PADDOCKS:** If you remove your horse from a paddock please return them to the same place when finished. Do not place your horse in a different area. If you have an emergency or cannot get your horse to its designated area, please put them in a stall. Horses are separated into groups that BRF finds appropriate and mixing the groups could be dangerous to the handler or to the horse.
